The revised PILOT for Brewster Industrial Owners project for the 10-year PILOT was worked out and passed by the Southeast Town Board on October 12<sup>th</sup>, the County Legislature approved it on February 6<sup>th</sup>, and the Brewster School Board will vote on February 27<sup>th</sup>. PCIDA will review and approve later – the PILOT will not take effect until after a C of O is approved. The PILOT will not take effect until 2025.
