Update regarding PCIDA future: Arrangements for new office space.

The room known as the library in the current building will be the new office space for the PCIDA. The proposed start date is April 1st and the rent will be \$1000 which includes utilities and use of conference room.

The revised PILOT for Brewster Industrial Owners project for the 10-year PILOT was worked out and passed by the Southeast Town Board on October 12<sup>th</sup>, the County Legislature approved it on February 6<sup>th</sup>, and the Brewster School Board voted on February 27<sup>th</sup> and tabled the issue pending a full quorum. The Brewster School Board voted again on March 12<sup>th</sup> and approved the PILOT 4 to 3. PCIDA will review/decide later – the PILOT will not take effect until after a C of O is approved.
