*Chairman's Report:

Updated regarding PCIDA future: The County will have a new Commissioner of Planning, Economic Development and Transportation, Barbara Barosa.

Our "budget request" was well received by the County Legislature. We did not ask for funding in 2024 and we confirmed that we would not be using the 2023 allocation of \$40,000.

*Chairman's Report(cont.):

Reported on the Oct. 12th meeting with Director of Personnel, Paul Eldridge, and Director of Consumer Affairs, Mike Budzinski, regarding use of the Consumer Affairs Compliance Inspector to work with our Board for on-site workforce compliance visits. They are not averse to the idea, but pointed out many items that need to be considered. Much depends on where we stand in the Count organization.

Approval by County of revised PILOT for Brewster Industrial Owners project for the 12-year has been superseded by a 10-year PILOT that was worked out and passed by the Southeast Town Board on Oct. 12th. This new PILOT now needs to be approved by the County and the Brewster School Board.

The issue of compliance with the PCIDA Workforce Policy and Agency enforcement was discussed.

Letters requesting compliance with records availability were sent. Ace Endico replied, still no reply for Brewster Industrial Owners.
